ERWA program activities are implemented in (15) provinces in Iraq except the three northern provinces, The activities included implementation of (lectures, galleries, workshops, plays, etc), and distribution of ERWA materials like (posters, folders, snake and ladder, maze and T-shirts) during the implementation of the activities.
