The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

<u>Programs</u> Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

MOUSLThe second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016

The IRCS approach Ninawa, Mosul beside the camps

26th -27th November 2016

The Duhook branch of the IRCS has approach the north of Mosul liberated villages to offer relief for the residence and survey what is required further in the next visits. Meanwhile Erbil and Salahaddin branches continue to assist the families inside and outside camps, their activities summery as following: -

The IRCS Duhook Branch

The IRCS responded to 254 families with 260 food baskets in newly liberated villages next to Tel-Kef [Al-Hoqool village 102 families, Najmok village 22 families while in Tel-Yabbis residence were 40 families and they host 90 families displaced from Mosul (Al-Qahera, Al-Hadbba'a, Al-Arqoobb and Bawezaa).]

The IRCS Erbil Branch

The Erbil branch continue to support Khazer and Hasan Shame camps during the 26th and 27th inside the camps activities as following: -

A. Camps

Khazer Camp

- 1800 total hot meals delivered to new families in cooperation with the BCF
- 434 medical cases treatments

Hasan Shame 2

- This camp received 206 families in the past two day and each family received ready meals on arrival
- Distribution of 200 stove, Jerri can, hygiene set and 4 blankets per families

Hasan Shame 1

- 310 medical cases treated during the Night shift
- The IRCS and the Turkish Red Crescent distributed 250 food baskets ,350 cloth box and 1400 blankets

The IRCS Health department team's total activities during the past two days inside the camps were First Aid training for 90 people, open- day psychosocial support beneficiaries 308 children and tent visit 70.

B. Mosul city

- On the 27th and after one day of liberating the AL-Khadhra'a apartment compound the IRCS with Qatar Red Crescent distribution of 250 food baskets
- 2) Hamam Al-Alil families received 500 food baskets and 500 cloth box


The IRCS Salahaddin Branch

On the 26th the 3000 fresh bread were distributed evenly between the vulnerable families inside camp Al-Hajaj and Jada'a beside the vulnerable inside Tikrit city (Hay Al-Qadysea and Hay Mea'at Darr

On the 27th the 3000 fresh bread were distributed on camps of Tel-Sebat 41 families, Al-Hajaj camp 130 families while inside Tikrit city Hay Al Zohor 70 families and Hay Al – Shuhada'a 59 families
