



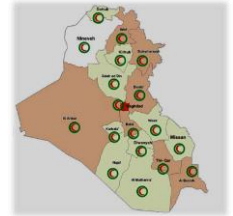

MOUSL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

.The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism
After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016



The IRCS continue its relief operations with its partners

12th November 2016

1. Team One Salahaddin, Basra and Thi- Qar branches with the IRCS /HQ

Fresh bread (**3000** pieces) is daily distributed to **300** families between AL Hajaj camp and IDPs living in under construction buildings

Meanwhile AL-Hajaj camp received new arrival of 100 families from (South of Ninawa, Sherqat and Haweja'a whom received instantly ready meals.

Our team visited the IDPs in these under-construction site and delivered different health and medical services with the beneficiaries as following: -

Medical treatments to 196, First Aid to **9**, **Two** First Aid training sessions for **28** persons, Psychosocial support 213 to different age groups and Health promotion to **75**

2. Team Two Erbil, Mosul, Diala branches and IRCS/HQ

Khazer camp on the early dawn hours of 12th November 479 families (1298 person) arrived to Khazer while later that day another 30 families arrived (183 person) making total of 509 families (2481 person). Each of these families received ready meals beside our jointed Kitchen with BCF team provided more than 1500 hot meals to the new arrivals

Meanwhile our support to the residence of these camps continues as following: -

- Distribution **12000** fresh bread daily
- **200** family packages (food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen sets, hygiene sets and 2 Jerri cans)
- Distribution of **479** boxes of clothes (Qatar and Turkish Red Crescent)
- Distribution **1000** baby kits (baby milk powder, water bottle dozen sets and diapers) beside educating the mothers that these water bottles are exclusively used for baby milk formula
- Medical treatment of **180** medical cases
- Psychosocial support open day **180** day

- Khazer (2938 Families)
- Hasan Shame (1531 Families)
- Zeilkan Camp (546 Families)
- Jada'a (1200 Families)
- Al Haiai (311 Families)
