

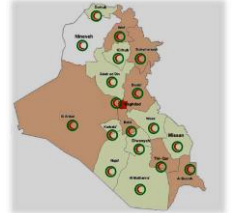


The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOUSL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

.The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016



The IRCS inside Mosul and Sherqat

13th November 2016

The IRCS brave determined teams served the vulnerable in Mosul and Sherqat armed with food and Nonfood items, they went at early morning hours of November ,13th into Mousl city and Sherqat beside continuing to support the peoples in nearby camps

1. Team One: The Salahaddin, Thi-Qar and Basra Branches aided by IRCS/HQ team

- This team went into Sherqat right side delivering 400 food baskets to the people of this city and promising with more aids soon.
- The daily activities
- 1. Fresh bread (3000 pieces) is daily distributed to 300 families between AL Hajaj camp and IDPs living in under construction buildings
- 2. Meanwhile AL-Hajaj camp received new arrival of 43 new families from (South of Ninawa, Sherqat and Haweja'a whom received instantly ready meals
- 3. While in Jada'a camp 500 families received 500 food baskets (include food baskets and 35Kg rice) and 3000 blankets

2. Team Two: The Erbil, Diala and Mosul branches aided by the IRCS /HQ team

- This team went early in the morning inside Hay Al-Intisar; eastern front of Mosul city with their trucks loaded with 500 food baskets and 500 winter cloth and blanket boxes distributed on the residence of this neighborhood
- This Team continue to support Khazer and Hasan shame camp
- 1. New arrival 23 families to Khazer camp 139 person covered by 1000 hot meals (lunch and dinner) also the IRCS provided Medical treatment of 150 case Khazer
- 2. 8000 fresh bread in Khazer and Hasan shame and 4000 Bread in Debaga
- 3. 200 boxes of winter cloths to children and adults in Khazer
- 4. While in Hasan shame distributing Services 200 baby set (baby milk powder, water bottle dozen sets and baby diapers) beside educating the mothers about the importance of Hygiene and water usage in baby milk formulas to avoid diarrheas.

- **Khazer (2961 Families)**
- **Hasan Shame (1531 Families)**
- **Zeilkan Camp (546 Families)**
- **Jada'a (1200 Families)**
- **Al Hajaj (354 Families)**
