<u>Programs</u> Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

**MOUSL** The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism



After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016

## The IRCS keep supporting the vulnerable in camps and cities

14th-15th November 2016

the IRCS team continue to support people day and night inside the camps and cities in 2 major operation zones

**Zone One Salahaddin** where team from our branches Salahaddin, Thi-Qar and Basra and the IRCS/HQ support the vulnerable at: -

- Hamam Al-Alil once again with 2000 food baskets
- Beside the 3000 fresh bread distributed to vulnerable between **Al Hajaj camp** and the IDPs in under construction building at **Hay Al- Jamaeya**.
- Jada'a camp supported with 1000 kitchen sets, stove 500, Jerri can 1000, hygiene kit 500, towels 2000 and 500 kettles

Zone Two Erbil where teams from our branches Erbil, Mosul, Diala and the IRCS/HQ supported in: -

- a) Mosul Hay Al-Samah, this time the IRCS distributed 250 food baskets to the residences 2<sup>nd</sup> neighborhood inside Mosul
- b) Khazer camp received: -
- 1. 143 families (563 person) on the 14<sup>th</sup> while on 15<sup>th</sup> November 350 families (2100 person) new arrived making total 493 families (2663 person) been delivered hot meals (lunch and dinner) total 3500 hot meals
- 2. 400 baby sets (Baby milk powder, water bottle dozen set and diapers) beside health promotion about water hygiene to avoid diarrhea.
- 3. Medical treatment of 150 cases
- 4. Open day psychosocial support for 180 children.
