

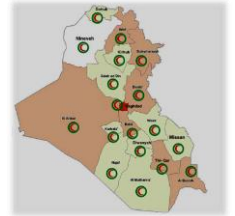


The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

.The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016



The IRCS send specialist physician to Khazer camp

17th November 2016

The IRCS started to send volunteer physician to examine and treat inside **Hasan shame** camp as part of its upgrading the medical services to the IDP camp

IRCS Erbil team

Supported by Baghdad branch activities in Khazer camp and Mosul summarized as following: -

A. In Khazer camp

1. 1000 hot meal distributed to the new 366 families arrived to Khazer camp
2. Medical treatment of 240 cases
3. 500 full relief package distributed (each pack contain food basket, stove, kitchen set, hygiene Kit ,2 Jerri cans, one 35Kg rice and water bottle dozen set)
4. Open day psychosocial support 190 children

B. In Mosul Hay al-Samah distribution of 250 food basket and we will visit them again soon

IRCS Salahaddin team

Supported by Baghdad branch activities in Rubaydha and Al-Hajaj camp

- A. 3000 fresh bread distribution to 300 families (175 families inside AL-Hajaj Camp, the other 175 families in Tikrit poor neighborhoods (Ehtefalat street and al Qadyssia)
- B. 58 families were relocated from Jada'a to Rubaydha camp and our team provided ready meals and water bottle dozen set to them
- C. These 58 families received psychosocial support for 300 person and health promotion and personal hygiene to 45 beneficiaries
