The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

<u>Programs</u> Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

MOSULT he second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016

The Hasan shame camp had new arrivals

20th November 2016

The IRCS Erbil Branch and Baghdad branch had reported that Hasan shame camp today received new arrivals after more than 2 weeks from no access to this camp ,131 new families make the total 1662 families occupancy in Hasan shame while Khazer camp received 191 new arrivals

The new families in Khazer received 1500 hot meals while in Khazer received 420 ready meals

Meanwhile our health and medical teams continue to provide support as following: -

- 1. Medical treatment 240 cases
- 2. First aid to 15 person
- 3. Psychosocial service in Hasan shame :-open day activity to 140 children, PSP to 20 adults

The IRCS Salahaddin and Baghdad branch supported

450 person during their screening in Al-Alam camp with 100 ready meals and 35 water bottle dozen set .
