The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

<u>Programs</u> Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

MOSUL The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016

The IRCS mandate allow us to serve more vulnerable people in different ways and means to alleviate their suffering and help them through all means possible as summarized in today bulletin

The Salahaddin Branch and Baghdad team support

- **Tel-Sebat camp** in Al-Alam had received 25 families displaced from Haweja'a and west bank Sherqat (since 17th November 58 families received but left with their guarantors the same incident happens on the 18th when 15 families came) they all received ready meals, fresh bread and water bottle dozen set during the remaining period (making total 98 ready meals, 1000 fresh bread and 28 water dozen set).
- Jada'a camp team of 3 staff went to the camp and made an awareness activity against the war remnant (ERWA) and another team follow the family links they received 4 request for family tracing (RFL)
- **Rubaydha camp** the health team was there to provide PSP, health promotion, first aid and medical treatment to the families as following

Distribution of 10 first aid kits, health promotion and personal hygiene 20 beneficiaries, medical treatment 50, while the PSP 15 children and 95 adults

• **Tikrit** Daily 3000 fresh bread where distributed, beside Tel-Sebat share mentioned above, inside Tikrit the vulnerable families at Al-Jamaeya 197 families, Al-Shuhada'a 90 families received their share of the bread. Al-Shuhada'a vulnerable families also received 50 food baskets

The Erbil branch and Baghdad branch

- Mosul city the IRCS team deliver to the families in Hay Al-Bakir and Kirkukly 750 food baskets this morning
- Hasan shame camp
 - 1. Received new 34 families, IRCS Team immediately distribute 300 ready meals to them
 - 2. Open the second medical clinic with the Qatar red crescent
- Khazer camp
 - 1. Received new 151 families, the IRCS team with BCF distribute 1200 hot meals to new arrivals
 - 2. The IRCS with the Turkish Red crescent distributed 2000 blankets and 500 cloth boxes
 - 3. Medical treatment of 260 cases


