The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality
.The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

MOUSL The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016

The Salahaddin branch Team with Baghdad branch support

- **Tel-Sebat** (**Rubaydha camp**) is more shaped as transient zone for the IDPs from sherqat and Haweja'a before their guarantors arrived to pick them up .so for the 4th day on the raw 50 families arrived received their ready meal, fresh bread and water dozen bottle set by the end of the day this amp host 15 families (total 5 ready meals and 17 water dozen set)
 - We also provided to these families 5 first aid kits, medical treatment to 45 persons, health promotion and personal hygiene to 25 persons while PSP program included 50 adults and 20 children
- 3000 fresh bread distributed to vulnerable families including the Tel-Sebat camp, Al Hajaj 197 families and 53 families in Hay Al-Qadyssia in Tikrit

The Erbil Branch Team with Baghdad Branch Team Support

- The health team of the IRCS Erbil and Baghdad branches been delivering health services between Hasan Shame and Khazer camps as following 20 beneficiaries from the first aid, PSP-open day 220 children, tent visit 22 while education and awareness for personal hygiene and awareness for hazard of war remnant to 220 children
- Khazer camp
 - 1. 97 new families received 800 hot meals in cooperation with the BCF
 - 2. Distribution of 200 blankets and 200 cloth box with the Qatar Red Crescent
 - 3. 280 medical treatment
- Hasan Shame
 - 1. 34 new families received 100 ready meals
 - 2. Start night shift at the medical clinic

***Note This table will show the latest camp occupancies and one can notice the last 3 camps are evacuating its IDPs while the first two has more influx of IDPs
