
## The IRAQI RED CERESCENT SOCIETY MOUSL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN



## **MOUSL**

The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism













## The Total of 7535 of IDPs added to camps!!

31st Oct.-2nd November 2016

The past days had added more families to the existing in camps of Khazer, Zeilkan and Jada'a. Making total of 1151 new families (7535 person) biggest wave was headed to Jada 798 families and it continue by the hour as we started to receive from Kok-gely area (suburban of Mousl city center).

The IDPs distributes according to nearest camp from where they had escaped fighting as; -

# new persons	Receiving camp
2435	Khazer
1600	Zeilkan
3500	Jada'a

The IRCS had received these families and provided readymade meals, fresh bread, relief items medical service evacuation to hospital and psychosocial support to alleviate their suffering immediately After surveying their needs, we provided food baskets, relief items.

Since the dawn of 17th Oct. till now the IRCS humanitarian response was: -

- **The Relief** distribution 565 ready meal ,2234 hot meal ,1500 food basket ,3.5-ton lentil ,187 water bottle dozen set .28tons of rice ,1236 kitchen sets, 800 stove ,1623 hygienic kits, 1600 Jerri can,934 cloth boxes and 5572 blankets
- The First Aid and Medical Services 80 different age at these camps
- The Psychosocial Support 3000 Of all ages include house visits

\*\*\*PS We were informed 1200 families stranded in Al Moafaqeya next to Basheqa on 2<sup>nd</sup> of November we will update you with news after our survey.
