





## MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..(22) 29<sup>th</sup> November 2016 Tuesday **with photo annex**

**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization, our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

**Programs** Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA  
Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality  
.The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran



**MOUSL** The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism  
After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016



### **The IRCS in Ninawa, Mosul, Al-Oujja beside the camps**

28<sup>th</sup> November 2016

The IRCS keep its 1<sup>st</sup> responding rule to the families in all areas that had witnessed liberation operation or displacement for any reason beside the IDPs inside the camp, the summary of this bulletin will demonstrate the intervention in Basheqa villages, Mosul city and Al-Oujja beside the camps: -

#### **The IRCS Duhook Branch**

1. **Sumakyyiat Al-Shabbak** is newly liberated village part of Basheqa county at border with Duhook, the IRCS teams went to support its 40 residing families with the relief items. Each family received (4blankets, food basket, stove, kitchen set, 2 Jerri can and hygiene set).
2. **Qaymawa camp (Zeilkan)**, our health teams provided first aid to 3 children, open day psychosocial support to 38 children and diffusion session to 24 adults through visiting 15 tents.

#### **The IRCS Erbil Branch**

##### **Mosul city**

The IRCS Erbil and Mosul branches went into Al-Fadhilya district to distributed 500 food baskets with cloth boxes and blankets with the Turkish Red Crescent

##### **Khazer Camp**

1. 750 hot meals distributed for the new families with the cooperation of the Barazani charitable foundation
2. 177 medical cases treated

##### **Hasan Shame 2**

1. 107 ready meals to the families
2. 125 food baskets with 35 kg rice, kitchen sets, stove, hygiene sets and 2 Jerri cans distributed per family

##### **Hasan Shame 1**

- 144 medical cases treated at the night shift

Health activities in the camps total 35 first aid ,100 children participated in open day psychosocial support while 55 tents visited for adults PSP

#### **The IRCS Salahaddin Branch**

1. An emergency appeal received by our team about displaced families from Kirkuk city center to **Al-Oujja city** (theses 144 families were prior displaced from different zones of Salahaddin to Kirkuk). Our Salahaddin branch immediately provided them with 144 food baskets ,288 mattresses and 864 Blankets
2. Also these families in al-Oujja received 20 first aid bags, medication to 60 people, health promotion and personal hygiene with poster to 50 persons beside the psychosocial support to 120 adults and 82 children
3. 3000 fresh bread were distributed to 125 families in **Al-Hajaj camp** ,70 families in **Tel-Sebat camp** while vulnerable people inside the city of **Tikrit** at al Haykel district 105 families
