### MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### PM/NOC in Qayara

7<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> June 2017

The IRCS Qayara station hosted meeting of the PM/NOC headed by General Al-Shemeri with the working local and international NGOs that focused on providing fuel, electricity, potable water, and endorsing medical services for the Camps residence.

**The past two-day's activities as listed below:**

#### The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

##### Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 13,300 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 400 ready meals pack distribution

##### Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 14,250 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 400 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 108,000 fresh bread distributed to 10,800 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama, Hamam Al-Alil, deserted building in Tikrit and the checkpoints
2. 200 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC beside 8 cases were transferred to Qayara hospital
3. 2000 families in Haj Ali camp received relief pack (each pack with food basket, 35Kg rice, kitchen set, hygiene set, stove, thermos, kettle, tarpaulin, 4 towels, 2 Jerri cans and 6 blankets) with the ICRC

##### EAS

IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC 20 medical cases from Badosh clinic to different hospitals operating as following:-

- To PMS hospital 15 cases
- To Taylor hospital one case
- To Aspen hospital 4 cases

**Inside Mosul** 1000 Families in Hay Al-Thoarah received relief pack (each pack of one food basket and 2 water bottle dozen sets)

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 572 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
3. 956 Medical cases treated in camps ;600 cases with Qatar RC and 356 cases in Hasan Shame night shift

##### Inside Mosul

- Trucking of 840 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
- 100 families in Hay Al-Intisar and Nabe Younis received food package (each pack of potato sack, cooking oil and 5 Kg rice) with Turkish RC

#### The IRCS Duhook Branch

Inside Nerkizlee 1 camp 809 families received cash donation with the German RC (finalizing the camp coverage by cash assistance)

The cash donation as following

- 16 families each received 125,000 IQD
- 212 families each received 200,000 IQD
- 252 families each received 300,000 IQD
- 56 families each received 350,000 IQD
