IFTAR FEAST

9th-10th June 2017

The IRCS Team opened its annual Iftar feast in the camps; we started in Hasan Shame with the donation from Turkish Airline and Turkish RC.

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches and IRCS/HQ

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 12,200 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 400 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 14,200 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 400 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 102,000 fresh bread distributed to 10,200 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama, Hamam Al-Alil, deserted building in Tikrit and the checkpoints
2. 198 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC beside 5 cases were transferred to Qayara hospital

EAS

IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC 12 medical cases from Badosh clinic to PMS hospital

Inside Mosul 1000 Families in Hay Al-Islah Al-Zera'e received relief pack (each pack of one food basket and 2 water bottle dozen sets)

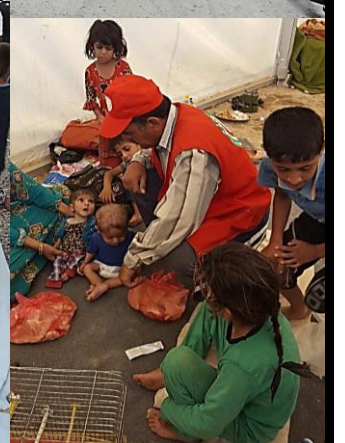
The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 572 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
3. 652 Medical cases treated in camps ;454 cases with Qatar RC and 198 cases in Hasan Shame night shift
4. 1000 families inside the camps received food basket with the IFRC and Turkish RC
5. 160 families in Jama Kur camp received cloth boxes with LC company
6. Iftar feast for 2000 person in Hasan Shame with the Turkish RC

Inside Mosul

- Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
- 100 families in Hay Al-Intisar and Nabe Younis received food package (each pack of potato sack, cooking oil and 5 Kg rice) with Turkish RC
