

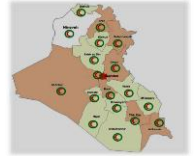

MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..(107) 19th June 2017 Monday **with photo annex**

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Special Needs Children

16th -18th June 2017

The IRCS teams prioritize the children with special need in relief, medical, health and psychosocial support and we have many success stories inside and outside camps.

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Aqrah Checkpoint

1. 13,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 400 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 12,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 600 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 156,000 fresh bread distributed to 15,600 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Al Salamyia, Jada'a, Shahama, Hamam Al-Alil, deserted building in Tikrit and the checkpoints
2. 298 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC beside 8 cases were transferred to Qayara hospital
3. Al Salamyia camp received 200 ready meal packs

EAS

IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC five medical cases from Al-Refae clinic to different hospitals operating as:

- To PMS hospital 3 cases
- To Taylor hospital one case
- To MSF hospital one case

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 858 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
3. 702 medical cases were treated; 540 cases with the Qatar RC and 182 cases at Hasan Shame night shift
4. 1,150 families received food basket in Hasan Shame with Turkish RC
5. 400 families in U2 received relief pack (each pack contain food basket, 35Kg Rice, hygiene set, kitchen set, stove, thermos, kettle, trapuline, 2 Jerri cans, 2 towels and 6 blankets) with the ICRC

Inside Mosul

- Trucking of 1,260 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC

The IRCS Duhook Branch

1. **Cash donation** delivered by the IRCS team **inside Duhook** to 242 IDP families with German RC
 - 242 families each received 200 USD
 - 39 person each received 100 USD
2. **Psychosocial support** to Al-Dawodyia camp for Yazidi Families 15 house visit and 11 women support beside success story of little child called Zainab that benefited from PSP and start to blend with her peers despite her special case of mental disorder
