

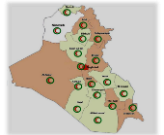

MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

Helping women to learn craft and support their families inside camps started in Khazer camp with donation from TIKA

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 16,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 300 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 13,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 500 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 156,000 fresh bread distributed to 15,600 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Al Salamyia, Jada'a, Shahama, Hamam Al-Alil, deserted building in Tikrit and the checkpoints
2. 281 ready meal packs delivered to families in Al-Salamyia screening zone
3. 163 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC beside 9 cases were transferred to Qayara hospital
4. 1500 families in Jada'a 6 camp received relief pack (each pack contain food basket, 35Kg Rice, hygiene set, kitchen set, stove, thermos, kettle, trapuline, 2 Jerri cans, 2 towels and 6 blankets) with the ICRC

Inside Mosul 2000 families received relief pack inside Hay Al-Zenjeely, Hay Al-Thora and Hay Al Sehha each pack of food baskets and 2 water bottle dozen sets

EAS IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC 18 medical cases

A. from Al-Refae clinic to different hospitals operating as:

- To PMS hospital 12 cases
- To Taylor hospital 2 cases
- To Aspen hospital 2 case

B. 2 Cases transferred from Aqrab check point: one case to Qatar Hospital while the other case to Qayara hospital

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 858 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
3. 657 medical cases were treated ;490 cases with the Qatar RC and 167 cases at Hasan Shame night shift
4. 200 families in Khazer received relief pack (each pack contain food basket, 35Kg Rice, hygiene set, kitchen set, stove, thermos, kettle, trapuline, 2 Jerri cans, 2 towels and 6 blankets) with the ICRC
5. 400 families in Hasan Shame received relief pack (each pack of food basket and hygiene set)
6. Opening cloth workshop in Khazer for widow with 100 sewing machines with TIKA

Inside city

- Trucking of 1,260 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
- 400 families in Hay Al-Bakir, Hay Eden, Hay Al-Zuhour and Hay Al-Mahallabeya inside Mosul received food baskets
- 2000 families of vulnerable IDPs and hosting communities received relief packs inside Erbil, with Knowledge University and private donor

The IRCS Duhook Branch

Inside Duhook Cash donation delivered by the IRCS team to 170 IDP families and 475 Syrian refugee families each received 200 USD beside 2 IDP singles each received 100 USD with German RC

Inside camp

- 734 families inside Derkaree camp received Hygiene sets beside health promotion and personal hygiene posters with German RC
- Psychosocial support to Krypto and Derkaree camp through 25-house visit benefited 9 men and 11 women
