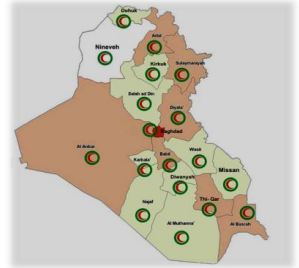




## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..(114) 6<sup>th</sup> July 2017 Thursday **with photo annex**

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### Relief Items Distribution

4<sup>th</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> July 2017

The newly arrived ID families within the past 48 hours from East of Mosul; received from the IRCS complete relief pack as listed in the report

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

#### The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

##### Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 8,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 500 ready meals pack distribution

##### Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 7,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 500 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 108,000 fresh bread distributed to 10,800 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama and the checkpoints
2. Total of 600 families (210 families in Jada'a 6 camp and 390 Families in Haj Ali camp) received relief pack (one food basket kitchen set, 35Kg rice, stove, hygiene set, kettle, thermos, tarpaulin, 2 Jerri cans, 4 towels and 6 blankets) with the ICRC
3. 174 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC beside

**EAS** IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC 8 medical cases from Al-Refae clinic

- To PMS hospital five cases
- To Aspen hospital 3 cases

**Mosul PHC** the IRCS Primary health care team examined and treated 435 cases with the Danish RC

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 525 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

**Inside Mosul** Trucking of 840 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC

#### The IRCS Duhook Branch

Ba'adree camp the IRCS health team had 15 tent visit and psychosocial support to 9 women
