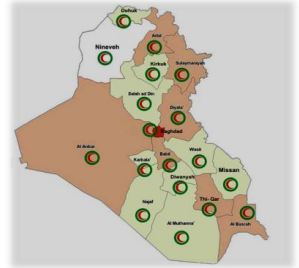




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Almost Liberated

6th -9th July 2017

Mosul is about to be liberated yet the IRCS team will continue to support the vulnerable inside and outside camps and ready for new liberation operations in other cities.

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 13,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1100 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 15,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 900 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 207,000 fresh bread distributed to 20,700 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama and the checkpoints
2. 1,425 families Haj Ali camp received relief pack (one food basket kitchen set, 35Kg rice, stove, hygiene set, kettle, thermos, tarpaulin, 2 Jerri cans, 4 towels and 6 blankets) with the ICRC
3. 85 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC
4. IRCS health team provided first aid lecture to 38 persons in Madraj camp and environment awareness to 40 children

EAS IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC one medical case from Al-Refae clinic to Aspen hospital

Inside Mosul

1. 1,950 families inside Mosul and surrounding villages received food basket with Algerian RC
2. 150 food baskets delivered to Al-Khansa'a hospital
3. **PHC** IRCS Primary health care team examined and treated 743 cases with the Danish RC

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 1,050 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul Trucking of 1,680 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC

The IRCS Duhook Branch

1. Cash distribution inside Duhook to 245 families, each family received 200 USD with German RC as following: -
 - 56 IDP families
 - 189 hosting community Families
2. Dissemination team delivered lecture on IHL for Syrian refugees in Domiz camp and Duhook city council
