

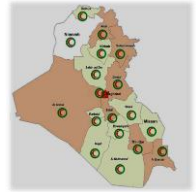

MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



WATER TRUCK HIT!

10th -12th July 2017

The IRCS with the French RC had trucked water to different locations inside Mosul for more than 2 months through private contractor yet one of the trucks was destroyed by mortar attack no human causality; we will continue to serve the people of Mosul despite all challenges.

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 11,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 600 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 11,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 700 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 159,000 fresh bread distributed to 15900 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama and the checkpoints
2. Madraj camp, IRCS health team provided psychosocial support to 38 children, first aid service to 12 people and first aid workshop 42 men

EAS IRCS team transferred with the Norwegian RC two medical cases from Badoosh clinic to PMS hospital

PHC IRCS Primary health care team examined and treated 424 cases with the Danish RC

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 787m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 1240 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. 350 families in Hay al Yarmook received food pack (10 Kg rice and cooking oil) with Turkish RC

The IRCS Duhok Branch

1. Cash distribution inside Duhok to 6 families, each family received 200 USD with German RC as following: -
 - One IDP family
 - 5 Hosting Community Families
2. Dissemination team delivered lecture in IHL to Karmawa camp
