




## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### First Aid Training In Tikrit

17<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> July 2017

Almost 1000 families from Mosul displaced in deserted building in Tikrit /Al-Qadyssia district, since their arrival the IRCS cover their needs including training the families through different workshop about first aid. The past few-day's activities as listed below:

#### The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

##### Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 12,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1,200 ready meals pack distribution

##### Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 13,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 1,100 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 180,000 fresh bread distributed to 18,000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama and the checkpoints
2. 419 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC

##### Inside Cities:

1. At Mousl PHC 632 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. Two first aid workshop in Tikrit for IDPs and distribution of first aid bags to families

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 787 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
3. Distribution of 5000 Jerri cans and 1500 water bottle dozen sets in Al-Salamyia 1 and 2 and Burtallah with Turkish RC
4. 500 water bottle sets were distributed for the pupils at the exam centers

##### Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 1,260 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. 400 families in Hay Aden and Al-Arygeia received food baskets with the Algerian and Turkish RC
