# **Area: Checkpoints**

20th -21st July 2017

The IRCS since day one of MLO secured the first responder role to the families escaping Mousl and in preparing for the new operation will concentrate the efforts at the checkpoints at the south and south east of Mosul The past two-day's activities as listed below:

# The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

## **Aqrab Checkpoint**

- 1. 10,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
- 2. 900 ready meals pack distribution

### **Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint**

- 1. 11,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 2. 800 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

#### The Camps

- Producing and distribution of 72,000 fresh bread distributed to 7200 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a ,Shahama and the checkpoints
- 2. 92 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC

#### **Inside Cities:**

At Mousl PHC 191 medical cases treated with the Danish RC

# **Inside camps**

- 1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
- 2. Producing and distribution of 525 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

#### **Inside Mosul**

- 1. Trucking of 840 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
- 2. 400 families in Hay Al-Yarmouk and Nabe Younis received food baskets with the Algerian and Turkish RC

#### The IRCS Duhook Branch

- 1. 173 families in Qaymawa camp received 195 stoves with the German RC
- 2. The IRCS heath team had psychosocial support to families in Ba'adree camp through 15 tent visit to 12 men and 11 women
