With the increasing temperatures to almost 50°C increasing the pressure on the PHC run by the IRCS inside and outside the camps to manage the medical cases

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Agrab Checkpoint

- 1. 11,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
- 2. 1,100 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

- 1. 11,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 2. 900 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 48,000 fresh bread distributed to 4800 families at the checkpoints
- 2. 403 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC
- 3. First aid treatment 31 cases
- 4. Open day for 62 children in Madraj camp

Mousi PHC 507 medical cases treated with the Danish RC

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
- 2. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul

- Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
- 2. 150 families in hay Al-Zuhoor received food baskets with Turkish RC
