

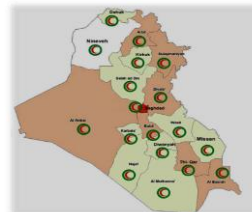

Health Services

24th -26th July 2017

The IRCS Health teams are back in camps to provide first aid, psychosocial support and health promotion and personal hygiene education and awareness to the IDPs.

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 17,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1,500 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 15,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 1,500 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 108,000 fresh bread distributed to 10,800 families at the checkpoints and camps
2. 392 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit with the Danish RC and transporting 2 cases to Qayara hospital
3. First aid treatment 60 cases
4. The health team had the following services in Madraj and Jada'a camps
 - Open day for 182 children
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene awareness to 58 persons
 - First aid workshop 25 person

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 787 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 1,260 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. 784 families in Turuq village benefit from Cash distribution of 365,000 IQD per family with German Red Cross
