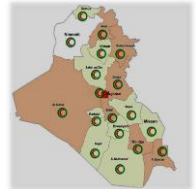




## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### Cash Distribution in €

31<sup>st</sup> July-2<sup>nd</sup> August 2017

The IRCS with the Danish RC continue the cash distribution to vulnerable families inside the cities and district in Kurdistan including the IDP and the Syrian refugee families.

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

#### The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

##### Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 13,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 2300 ready meals pack distribution

##### Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 13,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 2300 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 180,000 fresh bread distributed to 18,000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama, the checkpoints and inside Tikrit.
2. 308 medical cases were treated in Madraj medical center, 8 emergency admission and 70 minor surgery management with Danish RC
3. Camp Jada'a 4 and 5; the IRCS health team provided: -
  - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 27 children and 18 women
  - Psychosocial support to 10 tent visit
  - First aid workshop to 20 men

**Mosul 's PHC IRCS:** - Primary health care team examined and treated 669 cases with the Danish RC

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 787 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

##### Inside Cities

1. Inside Mosul Trucking of 1,260 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. 1,495 families received each 200 Euros: 994 IDP families in Shahan city, Serahdan and Pera Rash beside 551 Syrian families in Kasinzan district with the Danish RC

#### The IRCS Duhook Branch

Khanaky camp the IRCS team provided

- Psychosocial support through :-Open day to 42 children and 10 tent visits
- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 11 men
