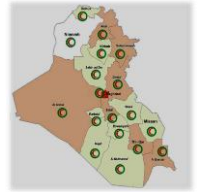




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Assessing The Needs

3rd -4th August 2017

The IRCS and its partners had been assessing repeatedly the IDP family's needs inside and outside the camp through different field surveys and meeting with the local authorities and camp management to organize our response to serve the ultimate goals.

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 10,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1400 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 10,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 1400 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 fresh bread distributed to 12,000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama, the checkpoints and inside Tikrit.
2. 189 medical cases were treated in Madraj medical center and 29 minor surgery management with Danish RC
3. Jada'a 4 camp the IRCS health team provided Health promotion and personal hygiene to 15 of camp management staff

Mosul's PHC IRCS Primary health care team examined and treated 210 cases with the Danish RC

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Cities

1. Inside Mosul Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. 147 IDP families received each 200 Euros in Pera Rash, Kasinzan and Serahdan with the Danish RC

The IRCS Duhook Branch

Domiz2 camp for Syrian refugee the IRCS Teams provided

- Open day to 47 children and 10 tent visits
- Health promotion and awareness against cholera to 13 women
