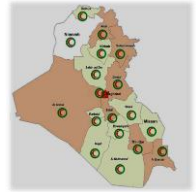




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Flow from west of Mosul

5th -7th August 2017

250 families from west of Mosul displaced to the south and south east of Mosul within the past four days mostly from village of Mahalabyia, Mazrah and Al-Kosek

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 14,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1600 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 12,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 1800 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp
3. Psychosocial support and health promotion to 122 children

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 180,000 fresh bread distributed to 18,000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Shahama, the checkpoints and inside Tikrit.
2. 390 medical cases were treated in Madraj medical center, 2 emergency admissions and 45 minor surgery management with Danish RC
3. Jada'a 3 camp
 - the IRCS first aid workshop to 12 of camp management staff
 - Psychosocial support as open day to 42 female children and 14 tent visits

Mosul's PHC IRCS Primary health care team examined and treated 878 cases with the Danish RC

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 787 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul Trucking of 1,260 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC

The IRCS Duhook Branch

Dawoodyia camp the IRCS team delivered

- Psychosocial support to 10 tent visit and open day to 110 children
- Awareness to mumps to 13 women
