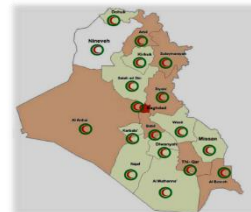

LISTEN AND SUPPORT

14th -15th August 2017

The people difficulties provoke the IRCS psychosocial teams for the second day back to Mosul at Wade Al Eyen to provide psychosocial support to the people and children and arranged with local hospital to transfer difficult cases for specialist psychiatrist.

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin, Karbala and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 10,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1,400 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 10,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 1,400 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 fresh bread distributed to 12,000 families at the checkpoints and camps
2. 128 medical cases treated at Madraj camp medical unit, 1 cases admission and 30 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. 80 families in Madraj received relief pack (kitchen set, kettle, stove, hygiene set, 2 Jerri can, thermos, tarpaulin, 2 towels and 6 blankets) with the ICRC

Inside Mousl

1. IRCS/ PHC 448 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. Psychosocial support in Wade Al-Eyen
 - Provided 11 house visits total 52 people
 - Visit Al-Quds and Al-Hamden elementary schools ; Psychosocial support to 10 teachers and open day to 563 pupils

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 240 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
