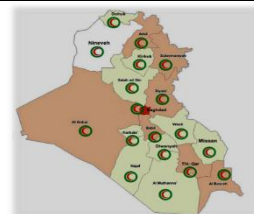




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

War Remnants

16th- 18th August 2017

The IRCS /ERWA team start awareness against war remnant to schoolchildren and they are cooperating with local authorities for safety markers.

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin, Karbala and Mosul Branches

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 16,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 2000 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 13,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 2300 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 180,000 fresh bread distributed to 18,000 families at the checkpoints and camps
2. 81 medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 3 cases admission and 25 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC

Inside Mosul

1. IRCS/ PHC 562 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. The IRCS team in Hay Al-Mammon and Hay Al-Aghadeer
 - Provided 8 house visits total 38 people, seven men referred to psychiatrist
 - Visit Hager and Al-Aghadeer elementary schools; Psychosocial support to 10 teachers and open day to 621 pupils
 - ERWA team education to 213 girls in same school

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 787 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 1,260 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 360 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil

The IRCS Duhok Branch

Domiz2 camp the IRCS Team delivered

- Awareness about mump to 13 people
- Psychosocial support to 61 children and 9 women
- 2 Vocational training workshops for hair and beauty for women
- IHL lecture to staff and volunteers of the camp management

Krypto 1 camp

- IHL lecture to staff and volunteers at camp management
- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 15 people
