The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### Qademoon Ya Tel-Afar

19<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup> August 2017

On the Dawn of August 20<sup>th</sup> commenced Tel-Afar liberation operation, the IRCS Team were at Hamam Al-Alil checkpoint serving the families from Tel-Afar today 216 persons arrived making total of 1804 families into camps and 500 families inside Mosul at Hay Al-Rashedyia (2304 Families)

Those from Tel-Afar, Mahallabeya, Abo-Maria, Al-Ayadia, Al-Mazara'a and Al Kassk supplied with ready meal packs, hot meals, water, bread and psychosocial support. Then settled inside camps of Hamam Al-Alil .Jada'a4 and 5 and Haj Ali

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

#### The IRCS Salahaddin, Dewanyia, Wasit and Mosul Branches

##### Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 8,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1,600 ready meals pack distribution

##### Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 9,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 1500 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 fresh bread distributed to 12,000 families at the checkpoints and camps
2. 312 medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 7 case admission and 66 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. In Madraj Health team provided:-
  - Psychosocial support to 22 men
  - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 62 children and 20 men

##### Inside Mosul

1. IRCS/ PHC 446 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. 2000 families in Mesheryafa received food baskets

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 525 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

##### Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 840 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 240 m<sup>3</sup> by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
3. 113 IDP families inside Erbil received each 200 Euros with Danish and German RC
4. 500 IDP families from Tel-Afar received hot meals and food baskets with Turkish RC

#### The IRCS Duhok Branch

Domiz2 camp the IRCS Team delivered

- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 15 people
- Vocational training workshop for hair and beauty for women (graduation ceremony)
- IHL lecture to Syrian Refugees
