Tel-Afar IDPs

21st -22nd August 2017

During the past 48 hours, some families from Hama Al-Alil camp allocated with the new arrival 18 person making total 2,174 in Khazer M2. On 22^{nd} August, 44 person new arrival from Tel-Afar to Hamam Al-Alil camp

The IRCS team in three sectors distributed 4,722 Food baskets

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin, Al-Muthana, Wasit and Mosul Branches and IRCS/HQ

Aqrab Checkpoint

- 1. 9,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
- 2. 1,500 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

- 1. 12,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 2. 1,200 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 fresh bread distributed to 12,000 families at the checkpoints and camps
- 2. 303 medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 9 case admission and 48 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
- 3. 359 Families in Madraj received non-food items (kitchen set , hygiene set , tarpaulin , stove ,kettle thermos ,2 Jerri cans 2 towel and 6 blankets)with the ICRC
- 4. In Madraj and Hamam Al-Alil camps Health team provided;
 - Psychosocial support to 14 men
 - Health promotion ,personal hygiene and prevention of communicable diseases and STD to 284 people
 - First Aid workshop to 17 people

Inside Mousl

- 1. IRCS/PHC 456 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
- 2. 4000 families in Hawe Al-Kanessa and Hay 17th July received food baskets

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
- 2. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
- 3. 250 families in Haj Ali camp received food basket with the French RC

Inside Mosul

- 1. Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
- 2. Production and distribution of 240 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil

The IRCS Duhook Branch

In camps Sharia camp for IDPs and Domiz 2 for Syrian refugees the IRCS Team delivered

- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 25 people
- Education on child marriage and its danger for Syrian refugees
- IHL lectures in both camps

In Mosul 472 IDP families in Hay Al-Wahdaa received relief pack (food basket.5Kg Rice, 2 Jerri cans, lantern and 4 blankets).
