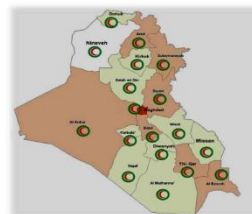




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL & TEL-AFAR LIBERATION OPERATION

EAS team

23rd -24th August 2017

The emergency evacuation services (EAS) team with the ambulances are ready to transport emergency cases. Within the past 48 hours only 70 men displaced from Tel-Afar to Hamam Al-Alil.

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin and Baghdad Branches and IRCS/HQ

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 10,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 1,600 ready meals pack distribution

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 10,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 1,600 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 96,000 fresh bread distributed to 9,600 families at the checkpoints and camps
2. 219 medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 9 case admission and 41 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC

Inside Mousl

1. IRCS/ PHC 424 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. 4000 families in Hay Al-Harmaat and Al-Eqtissadyen received food baskets
3. Inside East Mousl the IRCS health team provided
 - Psychosocial support through 5 house visit and total 75 person
 - Open day at to 104 pupils
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 20 people

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 300 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil

The IRCS Duhook Branch

Inside cities: - 29 Families inside Duhook and Erbil received each 200 euros with Danish RC

Inside Domiz 2 camp

- organizing football match
- Psychosocial support through 10 families house visits
- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 12 person
