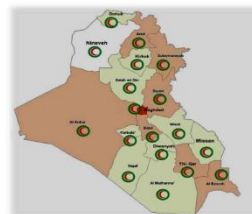




## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL & TEL-AFAR LIBERATION OPERATION

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### Displacement from Al-Ayadhia

28<sup>th</sup> -29<sup>th</sup> August 2017

The IRCS immediately responded to 121 new families displaced from (Al-Ayadhia/Tel-Afar) through Hamam Al-Alil checkpoint, distributed as 92 families in Nimrud camp and 29 families in Hasan Shame.

The past two-day's activities are listed below:

#### The IRCS Salahaddin, Wasit, Al-Muthana and Baghdad Branches

##### Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint

1. 8,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 123 ready meal packs in Hamam Al-Alil camp

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 fresh bread distributed to 12,000 families at the checkpoint, camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 270 medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 7 case admission and 41 minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. 250 families in Madraj camp received relief pack (kitchen set, hygiene set, tarpaulin, kettle, thermos, stove, 2 towels, 2 Jerri cans and 6 blankets)
4. 350 new families in Al-Salamyia3 camp received relief pack (food basket, 35 Kg rice, Kitchen set and hygiene set)
5. The IRCS Health team delivered inside Madraj Camp the following :-
  - Lecture on AIDS and viral hepatitis to 25 people
  - Personal hygiene to 55 children
  - First aid workshop to 30 people

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
6. 200 families in Hasan Shame received relief pack (food basket, 35 Kg rice, kitchen set, hygiene set, tarpaulin, kettle, thermos, stove and 2 Jerri cans)
2. 250 families in Nimrud camp received family pack with French RC
3. 250 families in Nimrud camp received food baskets, water bottle set and cooking oil with Turkish RC
4. Producing and distribution of 525 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

##### Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 840 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 300 m<sup>3</sup> by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
