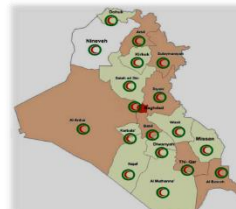




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL & TEL-AFAR LIBERATION OPERATION

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Salahaddin, Wasit, Al-Muthana and Baghdad Branches

Hamam Al-Alil Checkpoint 7,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 fresh bread distributed to 6,000 families at the checkpoint, camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 272 medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 1 case admission and 42 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. 375 new Families in Al- Salamyia3 camp received relief pack (food basket , 35 Kg rice , Kitchen set and hygiene set)
4. The IRCS Health team delivered inside Jada'a Camp the following :-
 - Lecture on AIDS and viral hepatitis to 31 people
 - Personal hygiene to 22 adults

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp

Inside Mosul

1. Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks inside different districts with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 300 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
