414 families displaced families from West Anbar since beginning of liberation operation; the families are temporary stationed at Kilo 18 before resettling in Amryah Al- Fallujah and Habbanyia camps

The past few day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Anbar Branch

- 1. Distribution of 45 water bottle sets to families arriving to the screening zone
- 2. 225 families received food baskets at Kilo 18 camp with Algerian RC

The IRCS Salahaddin & Mousl Branches

The Camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 180,000 fresh bread distributed to 18,000 families in camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
- 2. 9,000 Hot meals distributed inside Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 3. 800 Ready meal packs distributed inside Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 4. 343 Medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 6 cases admission and 34 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
- 5. The IRCS health team delivered health promotion and personal hygiene education to 232 children and 38 adults in Jada'a camp

EAS transport of one critical case from Mosul general hospital to Khansa'a hospital with the Norwegian RC

Inside Mousl

- IRCS/ PHC 866 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
- Psychosocial support to 88 school children ,7 house visits and 19 person

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 728 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
- 2. Production and distribution 90,000 bread inside camps

Inside Mousl

- 1. Trucking of 1,260 m³ of potable water to tanks in different districts in Mosul city with the French RC
- 2. Production and distribution of 300 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil

The IRCS teams at Domiz camp for Syrian refugee delivered:-

- Psychosocial support to 66 children and 5-house visit
- Health promotion and personal hygiene to 57 person
