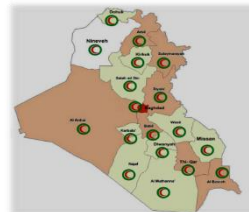




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Haweja'a Liberation Operation

21st -22nd September 2017

21st September start of Haweja'a liberation operation, the Salahaddin branch IRCS teams at reception area in Haj Ali ready to respond for displaced families

September 22nd our Anbar team was first team enter liberated Anah district and assessed family's needs in the city to respond

Total 544 families displaced from liberation operation; Haweja'a 377 and from West Anbar operation 167 in past 48 hours

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Anbar Branch

Kilo 18 Checkpoint

1. Distribution 182 ready meal packs sets to families arriving to the screening zone
2. Psychosocial support to 68 person
3. Evacuation 223 families for Falluja camps

The IRCS Salahaddin & Mousl Branches

Haj Ali Checkpoint

377 families displaced from Al-Farage (Makhmor) and Shirqat received ready meal packs

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 fresh bread distributed to 12,000 families in camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 133 Medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU and 17 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC

Inside Mousl

1. IRCS/ PHC 110 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. Psychosocial support in Hay Al-Amail for 247 children, 3 house visits with 7 adults

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
2. Production and distribution 60,000 bread inside camps

Inside Mousl

1. Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks in different districts in Mosul city with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 200 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
