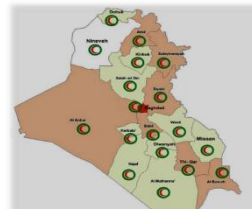




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



West Shirqat

25th -26th September 2017

The IRCS went inside the liberated area in west Shirqat and distributed food baskets for the first time. 89 families displaced from West Anbar operation in the past 48 hours and no displacement from Haweja'a. The past two-day's activities are listed below:

The IRCS Anbar Branch

Kilo 18 Checkpoint and camp

1. Distribution of 175 ready meal packs to families arriving to the screening zone
2. Distribution of 100 Jerri cans and 50 stoves
3. Psychosocial support to 40 men
4. Health promotion and personal hygiene to 56 persons
5. Assist in evacuation of 149 families to Falluja camps

The IRCS Salahaddin Mousl, Wasit, Al-Muthana and Baghdad Branches

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 120,000 fresh bread distributed to 12,000 families in camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 293 Medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU, 3 cases admitted and 64 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. Health team delivered in:
 - Haj Ali and Jada'a 3 camp psychosocial support to 125 children
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene in Madraj camp to 113 children

EAS Transporting 4 cases with Norwegian RC as-

- One case IRCS/PHC in Madraj to MSF hospital
- One case from Mousl General Hospital to Qatari hospital
- 2 cases from Nablus hospital to Qayara airbase

Inside Mosul

1. IRCS/PHC 542 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. Distribution of 1950 food baskets to families in Hay Al-Refae
3. Psychosocial support in Hay Al-Tayaran and Tel-Ruman in Mosul for 525 children, 14 house visits with 30 adults

Villages of West Shirqat

720 families received food baskets at Sedara Al Aullya, Sedara Al-Wasstah, Al-Fahad and Al-Nayfah villages

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 525 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
2. Production and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps

Inside Mousl

1. Trucking of 840 m³ of potable water to tanks in different districts in Mosul city with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 200 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
