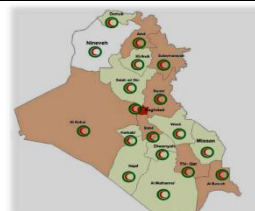




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Food Baskets

30th Sept.-2nd October 2017

The IRCS Teams supported 3 areas inside Mosul with Food Baskets part of 50,000 food baskets distribution plan. During the past 72 hours 85 families displaced from West Anbar and no family from Haweja'a. The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Anbar Branch

Kilo 18 Checkpoint and camp

1. Distribution 250 ready meal packs sets to families arriving to the screening zone
2. Distribution of 175 water bottle sets
3. Assistance in evacuation 150 families to Fallujah camp
4. The IRCS health and WASH team delivered :-
 - First aid lectures to 53 men
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene lectures 67 person
 - Psychosocial support to 86 children and 22 tent visits

The IRCS Salahaddin & Mousl Branches

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 180,000 fresh bread distributed to 18,000 families in camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 375 Medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU and 89 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. Health team delivered :-
 - Lectures on Health promotion and personal hygiene in Haj Ali camps to 21 children
 - Psychosocial support to 63 children

Inside Mosul

1. IRCS/ PHC 617 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. Distribution of 1920 food baskets to families in Hay Al-Saha

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 787 m³ of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
2. Production and distribution 90,000 bread inside camps

Inside Mousl

1. Trucking of 1260 m³ of potable water to tanks in different districts in Mosul city with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 300 m³ by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
3. 1000 food basket distributed to families in Hay Al-Sokar and Al-Muthana

The IRCS health team delivered in Ba'adree camp psychosocial support to 47 children, 15 house visits and 25 person
