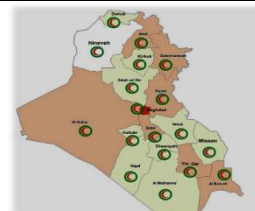




## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### Al-Alam 3 Camp

3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> October 2017

Al-Alam 3 Camp hosts displaced families from Sherqat and Haweja'a; the IRCS teams assessed and respond to the needs. During the past 72 hours 54 families displaced from West Anbar and no family from Haweja'a.

The past few-day's activities as listed below:

#### The IRCS Anbar Branch

##### Kilo 18 Checkpoint and camp

1. Distribution 300 ready meal packs sets to families arriving to the screening zone
2. Distribution of 355 water bottle sets

#### The IRCS Salahaddin & Mousl Branches

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 180,000 fresh bread distributed to 18,000 families in camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 480 Medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU and 45 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. 600 Families in Al-Alam 3 camp received relief pack (food baskets, 35 Kg rice, kitchen set, stove and Hygiene set) with the ICRC
4. Health team delivered Haj Ali and Nimrud camps :-
  - Lectures on Health promotion and personal hygiene in to 192 children and 18 men
  - Psychosocial support to 23 tent visit and 236 adult

**EAS** one case transferred from Mousl General Hospital to Aspen hospital with Norwegian RC

**Inside Mosul:** IRCS/ PHC 897 medical cases treated with the Danish RC

#### The IRCS Erbil Branch

##### Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 787 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
2. Production and distribution 90,000 bread inside camps

##### Inside Mousl

1. Trucking of 1260 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks in different districts in Mosul city with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 300 m<sup>3</sup> by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil

#### The IRCS Duhook Branch

The IRCS health team delivered

1. **Inside Mousl** lectures on health promotion and personal hygiene in Al-Aman school for 10 teacher and 30 students
2. **Khanky and Domiz 2 camps**
  - Psychosocial support to 116 children and 31 adults
  - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 77 person
