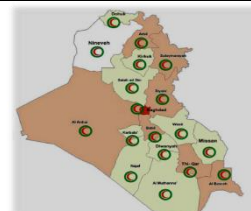




## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the Humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### Haweja'a Liberated

6<sup>th</sup> -7<sup>th</sup> October 2017

The Iraqi government declared end of Haweja'a liberation operations and our team will go to the liberated areas to support the families.

During the past 48 hours 58 families displaced from West Anbar.

The past two-day's activities as listed below:

#### **The IRCS Anbar Branch**

##### **Kilo 18 Checkpoint and camp**

1. Distribution 175 ready meal packs sets to families arriving to the screening zone
2. Distribution of 100 water bottle sets
3. Assist in evacuation 225 families toward Amrya Al-Falluja camp
4. The IRCS health team delivered Psychosocial support to 53 children, 17 tent visits and 21 families

#### **The IRCS Salahaddin & Mousl Branches**

##### **The Camps**

1. Producing and distribution of 24,000 fresh bread distributed to 2400 families in camps and deserted buildings in Tikrit.
2. 197 Medical cases treated at Madraj camp MU and 53 Minor surgery management with the Danish RC
3. 1500 Families in Al-Alam one and two camp received food baskets with Norwegian RC
4. Health team delivered in Nimrud and Haj Ali camps :-
  - Lectures on Health education to 23 women and 22 men
  - Psychosocial support to 35 children

**EAS** one case transferred from Haweja'a to American field hospital in Haj Ali with Norwegian RC

##### **Inside Mosul:**

1. IRCS/ PHC 189 medical cases treated with the Danish RC
2. 3940 food baskets distributed on families in Hay Al-Zenjeely and Al-Noor with ICRC

#### **The IRCS Erbil Branch**

##### **Inside camps**

1. Producing and distribution of 525 m<sup>3</sup> of water from M40 Unit inside the camp
2. Production and distribution 60,000 bread inside camps

##### **Inside Mousl**

1. Trucking of 840 m<sup>3</sup> of potable water to tanks in different districts in Mosul city with the French RC
2. Production and distribution of 200 m<sup>3</sup> by M5 with French RC inside Hamam Al-Alil
