The past few-day's activities as listed below:

The IRCS Anbar Branch

Kilo 18 Check point and camp

- Distribution of 175 ready meals pack
- Distribution of 175 water bottle sets to families
- 800 hot meals distributed to families (362 new families during liberation of Al-Qaim operation).
- Assist in evacuation 136 families to Amyria Al-Fallujah camps
- 196 families in Al-Abrar camp received relief pack each pack contain food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set, hygiene set, stove, kettle, thermos, tarpaulin ,2 Jerri cans ,2 towels and 6 blankets)

The Camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 300,000 fresh bread distributed to 30,000 families at camps and deserted building in Tikrit
- 2. 716 medical cases were treated in Madraj medical center and 147 minor surgery management
- 3. The IRCS team delivered Shahama, Al-Alam and Jada'a camps lectures in health promotion and personal hygiene to 73 children and 30 adults
