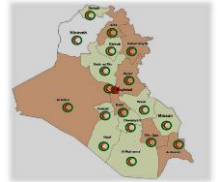

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman, Beirut and Tehran



MOUSL The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings, almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively; yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016

The world celebrates on 5th of December each year, **The Volunteer's Day** and the IRCS volunteers as always made tremendous efforts on field to serve the vulnerable and IDPs. Let us all salute their sacrifices, hard work and contribution to serve others.

Summarizing the IRCS staff and volunteer's achievements for this day: -

The IRCS Salahaddin, Muthana and Basra branch

Inside camps

1. Distribution of 3000 fresh bread to families inside Al Hajaj 100family Tel-Sebat 200family
2. Jada'a received 100 families from Mosul city center with ready meals and water bottle and evacuated the injured to the near hospital
3. Psychosocial support open day 113 children while PSP adult include 87 males 64 female

Inside villages of returnee (Al-Shoorra County)

1. Distribution of fresh bread, 4 blankets and food baskets to each family (186 families in Al Majman, 35 families Al-Shoorra Al-Jadeda, 175 families in Tel-Mahar, 85 families in Zalhaf, 550 families in Tel-Waye and 22 families in Al-Surooj)
2. Psychosocial support open day to 176 children, family visit 790 families, first aid service to 215 people, distribution 14 first aid bag, health promotion and poster 138 people and, first aid 5 workshops to 395 person

The IRCS Erbil, Mosul and Diala branch

Inside camps

1. 12000 fresh bread. Made and distributed
2. Khazer camp distribution of 700 hot meals
3. Hasan shame 85 new arrived families received ready meals with water bottle sets, 108 relief package delivered in Hasan shame 3 each package has (food basket, 35Kg rice, stove, kitchen sets and Hygiene set with 2 Jerri cans) beside a special case child with cerebral palsy received one-wheel chair, 2 blankets and extra 2 mattresses
4. Psychosocial support to 358 children and 10 tent visit, first aid lecture 45, person, health promotion and personal hygiene to 135 people while ERWA team delivered awareness for war remnant to 145 children
5. 270 medical cases treated and 74 medical cases at the night shift in Khazer and Hasan Shame respectively

Inside cities Al Shallalat County Tel-Yara village distribution of 350 food baskets, 350 cloth boxes and 1400 blankets and children diapers with the Turkish Red Crescent
