



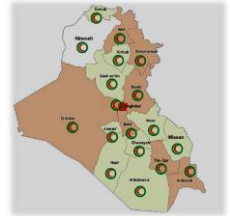

## MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran



**MOUSL** The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10<sup>th</sup> June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism  
After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17<sup>th</sup> October 2016



### **The IRCS revisit Qayara people**

6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> December 2016

The IRCS Teams schedule providing the vulnerable families with food baskets every 2-4 weeks depending on the food baskets distributed with reassessing the needs to continue their supports with all possible means, summarizing the day activities as following: -

#### **The IRCS Salahaddin, Basra and Muthana Branches**

Inside the camps

1. Distribution of 3000 fresh bread daily 100 families in Al Hajaj amp and 200 families in Tel-Sebat camp
2. 240 food basket distributed in Jada'a camp

Inside the city

1. Distribution of food baskets to 160 families inside Qayara suburb
2. Distribution of food baskets in Shweratt village to 100 families

#### **The IRCS Erbil, Diala and Mosul Branches**

Inside camps

1. Distribution of 12000 fresh bread
2. New arrival of 35 families to Hasan shame they received immediately ready meals and water bottle set
3. 500 hot meals delivered to new families in Khazer
4. Distribution of 19 baby sets (baby milk, diapers and water bottle sets) with education about importance of hygiene of baby milk formula
5. 125 food baskets distributed in Hasan Shame 3
6. 275 medical cases treated in Khazer
7. 70 cases treated in night shift at Hasan Shame
8. Health services
  - Health promotion and personal hygiene 151
  - First aid lecture to 54 beneficiaries
  - Psychosocial support for 115 children and 15 adults
