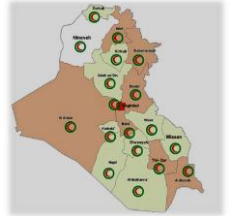
MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

Programs Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA

Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad , 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran



MOSUL The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism

After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016



The second month and IRCS continue to serve IDPs inside camps

16th December 2016

The Mosul liberation operation enter in its second month and IDPs arriving in regular smaller waves than the waves at the first month, the IRCS inside the camps are ready to receive these families as the first responder, to summarize the day activities as below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin, Babel and Karbala branches

1. 18 new families arrived to the camps
2. The health Team spend full day at Jada'a 2 camp to deliver the following activities
 - 13 Tent visit for 71 beneficiaries
 - Youth support 70 beneficiaries while adult diffusion session for 20 men
 - 6 First aid lectures to 84 beneficiaries
 - 7 Health promotion to 89 beneficiaries
 - Distribution of 25 first aid bags
 - First aid services to 30person
 - 2 lectures about awareness on war remnants
 - Open day 300 children

The IRCS Erbil, Mosul and Baghdad branches

1. 15000 fresh bread distributed to the camps
2. New arrived families to Khazer camp 63 families while Hasan Shame received 86 families
3. 2000 hot meals delivered to the new arrived families with water bottles
4. 220 food baskets distributed to new families in both camps
5. 323 medical cases treated in Khazer
6. 160 medical cases treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame
7. 60 blankets distributed to families
8. 65 baby sets distributed on the families (each set contain baby milk, baby bottle, diapers and water bottle sets)
9. 50 families received trash bags
10. The health teams between both camps and despite bad weather manage to have some activities as following
 - Open day 150 children
 - Adult Psychosocial support 111 beneficiaries
 - First aid lectures to 14 beneficiaries
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 50 families
