The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all. We are also an auxiliary body to public authorities/government when responding to humanitarian needs. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. our interventions alleviate the suffering for all, in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932

<u>Programs</u> Relief, First Aid and health services, WATSAN, Dissemination and IHL, Youth, RFL and ERWA Our Fundamental principles humanity, independence, impartiality, neutrality voluntary services, unity and Universality .The IRCS main structure distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman .Beirut and Tehran

MOSUL The second big governorate in Iraq with estimated 5.5 million population from different ethnic and sectarian origin living in harmony till 10th June 2014 when ISIS militants took control of the city center and surroundings ,almost half of the population left in large waves of internally displaced people or refugees toward safe zone inside Iraq and neighboring countries respectively ;yet almost 1.5 million still inside city center suffering severe agony and deprivation with high unemployment rate and bad economy as part of ISIS policies beside terrorism



After long preparations the Iraqi governments started the liberation operation joined by international coalition to salvage the great ancient city from ISIS oppression on early hours of 17th October 2016

M40 unit is on and Hasan Shame U2 is receiving IDPs

19th -20th December 2016

The IRCS with the French Red Cross and Qatar Red Crescent had succeeded in installing M40 unit (water purification unit) in Hasan Shame that will provide potable water to 40,000 people /day that mean saving more lives from water-borne diseases. Other major event was Hasan Shame U2 is receiving IDP families though is still under-construction during freezing days Summarizing the past two day activities as below: -

Inside the camps

- 1. 6000 fresh bread supplied in these two days to 300 families inside Tel-Sebat Camp
- 2. On the 19th Dec. the arrival of 84 new families in Tel-Sebat camp and our teams provided them with ready meals and water bottle

Inside the cities Distribution of 500 food baskets on the 19th Dec. inside Mosul at Hay Al-Zahra'a, Hay Al Samah and Kokgely

Inside the camps

- On the 19th Dec. New arrival of 241 families ,87 families reside in Khazer and 154 families in Hasan shame while on the 20th Dec. only Hasan Shame received 144 families.
- 2. 30,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps and planning to double the production
- 3. 2000 hot meals delivered to the new arrived IDPs with the BCF
- 4. 773 medical cases treated in Khazer with Qatar RC
- 5. 228 medical cases treated during night shift in Hasan Shame
- 6. 156 relief pack distributed between Khazer and Hasan Shame camp (each pack have food basket, 35Kg rice, hygiene sets, kitchen set, stove, 2 Jerri cans and tarpaulin).
- 7. 300 children inside Hasan Shame received chocolate, biscuits and pair of shoes from the Turkish Red Crescent
- 8. 280,000liters of potable water produced by the M40 unit and distributed to the residents of camps in 2 days
- 9. 100 families received in Hasan Shame U2 received relief package (hygiene set, kitchen set, tarpaulin ,4 blankets ,2 Jerri cans and one kettle) with the German Red Cross and ICRC

The Health teams inside the camps activities, open day 89 children, health promotion and personal hygiene for 167 children and 135 adults beside the vaccination monitoring campaign for polio and measles in the camps of Khazer1& 2, Hasan Shame3 and Debaga2

Inside the city_The IDPs of Halabcha received 300 food baskets, cloth boxes and blankets with the Turkish Red Crescent
