

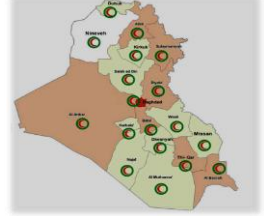


## The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..(42) 27<sup>th</sup> December 2016 S Tuesday **with photo annex**

**The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS)** is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.

The IRCS main structure is distributed on the 18 governorates including the capital Baghdad, 93 offices, with human power of 7530 volunteers and 2195 staff beside our offices in Amman, Beirut and Tehran.



### **The families from Khazer are going home**

25<sup>th</sup> -26<sup>th</sup> December 2016

During the 26<sup>th</sup> December families displaced from Kokjaleel to Khazer camp start going back to their liberated areas while Hasan Shame and other camps still receiving displaced families from Mosul and its surrounding villages.

The salahaddin team after surveying Nimrod and villages started to deliver their services in villages of Al-Salamyia, Al-Numanyia, Alabb-Nimrod and others.

The past two days' activities are summarized below: -

#### **The IRCS Salahaddin, Diala and Baghdad Branches**

##### **Inside the camp**

1. 6000 fresh bread distributed to 300 families in Tel-Sebat camp
2. Health teams in Jada'a camp delivered Jada different first aids to 86 people, distributed 10 first aid bag to the families and they delivered the psychosocial support to benefited 562 adults, lastly the health promotion and personal hygiene to 642 people
3. New 17 families arrived to Al-Hajaj camp received relief pack (food basket, kitchen set, stove, hygiene set, 6 blankets, thermos, 2 Jerri cans, kettle and 2 towels)

##### **Inside the cities**

1. Distribution of 600 food baskets to the families in Nimrod county (hosting communities and the IDPs from the west side of Mosul)
2. Health teams took the opportunity for psychosocial support to the families in Nimrod and their beneficiaries were 750 people

#### **The IRCS Erbil and Mosul and Kut branches**

1. During the past two days Khazer has received no families while Hasan Shame 265 new arrived families; **in a matter of fact 234 families returned home in Kokjaleel from Khazer camp.**
2. 30,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution of 2000 hot meals with the BCF
4. 534 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
5. 273 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
6. Our medical station in Hasan Shame U2 with specialist managed to treat 209 medical cases
7. Distribution 55 cloth boxes with blankets in Hasan Shame with the Turkish Red Crescent
8. Distribution of 237 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame
9. Distribution of 310 food baskets in Hasan Shame U2
10. Distribution 322000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
11. The IRCS health teams delivered Psychosocial support program including- the open day to 500 children and 114 adults beside the health promotion and personal hygiene to 293 people of different age group. And First aid delivered to 10 people.
