The days' activities can be summarized as below: -

## The IRCS Salahaddin Branches

6000 fresh bread distributed to 600 families in Tel-Sebat camp

## The IRCS Erbil and Mosul branch

- 1. Hasan Shame camp had 320 new arrived families.
- 2. 30,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
- 3. Distribution of 2500 hot meal with the BCF
- 4. 223 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
- 5. 140 medial cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
- 6. Our medical station in Hasan Shame U2 with specialist managed to treats 140 medical cases
- 7. Distribution in Hasan Shame U2 200 relief pack each relief pack (each pack contain one food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set ,2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin).
- 8. Distribution of 250 ready meals to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame
- 9. Distribution 172,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
- 10. Distribution trash bag to 70 families

The IRCS health teams delivered Psychosocial support program including-

- The open day to 200 children with the party beside tent visit for 4 families
- The health promotion and personal hygiene to 170 people of different age group
