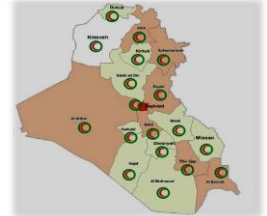




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The IDP waves continue from Mosul and majorly are received in Hasan Shame and the IRCS team is on the ground to assist the vulnerable with all possible ways and means.

We are supporting the kids with the clown party for the second day and gifting them small gift and chocolates.

The days' activities are summarized below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin Branches

6000 fresh bread distributed in Tel-Sebat camp 600 families

The IRCS Erbil and Mosul branches

1. 346 new families arrived to Hasan Shame
2. 30,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution 3000 hot meals (Rice with beans stew) with the BCF
4. 366 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
5. 67 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
6. Our medical station in Hasan Shame U2 with specialist managed to treat 170 medical cases
7. 100 families in Hasan Shame U2 received relief pack (each pack contains one food basket, 35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set, 2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin).
8. Distribution 240 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame
9. Distribution 159,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps

The IRCS health teams delivered

- Psychosocial support program including- the open day to 210 children for second day on the row with party to celebrate the new year not forgetting the adults with 62 tent visits
- The health promotion and personal hygiene to 70 people of different age group.
