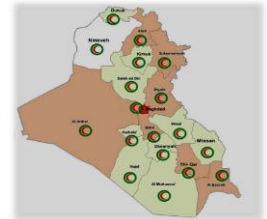




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..(48) 4th January 2017 Wednesday **with photo annex**

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



2 Camps Added to IDP Sheltering

2nd -3rd January 2017

The IRCs teams were first responders to 1352 families newly displaced from Mosul city toward three axes of safe zones camps beside the newly opened camps; Al-Shahama (Tikrit suburb) and Nerkizlee1 camp (Duhook border).

The past two days' activities are summarized below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin Branches

1. 12000 fresh bread distributed to 1145 families in Tel-Sebat
2. Our teams were first responder 565 newly arrived families with ready meals and water bottle sets to each family, these families were distributed between the camps of Qayara and Salahaddin as the following
 - 190 families to Jada'a 2
 - 260 families Jada'a 4
 - 75 families in Al-Shahama camp (newly opened camp)
 - Al-Hajaj 40 families

The IRCS Erbil and Mosul branches

1. Within the past two days the arrival of 729 families to the camps distributed as 568 in Khazer while Hasan Shame received 161 families of them
2. 60,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution of 4000 hot meals with the BCF
4. 712 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
5. 221 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
6. Our medical station in Hasan Shame U2 with specialist managed to treat 360 medical cases
7. 300 families in Hasan Shame U2 received relief pack (each pack contains one food basket, 35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set, 2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin).
8. Distribution of 558 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame & Khazer
9. Distribution 378,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
10. Distribution of trash bags to 140 families

The IRCS health teams delivered Psychosocial support program including- the open day to 360 children and 20 tent visits beside the health promotion and personal hygiene to 120 people of different age group.

The IRCS Duhook branch

The teams helped in evacuating 20 families from the screening zone toward Nerkizlee 1 camp and provided ready meals and water bottle set beside the 38 families that gradually evacuated to the same camp since new year eve making total 58
