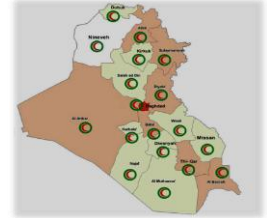




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



The IDPs outflow is decreasing

18th January 2017

For the past few days, there is rapid decrease in the IDP out flow from Mosul toward the camps and with almost steady returning number of the families back to their home in Mosul and its suburbs.

The past days' activities summarized below –

The IRCS Salahaddin, Najaf and Thi-Qar Branches

6000 fresh bread distributed to families inside the camps and the cities as

- 270 families in al-Shahama camp
- 100 families in Al-Hajaj camp

Inside the city at Tikrit university dormant 230 bags delivered to the students

The health activities delivered to two zone:-

- Al-Shahama camp; the first aid services to 14 person, distribution 12 first aid bags, first aid lecture to 14 adults, while the psychosocial support 35 adults, 20 teenagers and open day to 54 children. Lastly health promotion and personal hygiene to 121 beneficiaries.
- Al-Madraj camp first aid services to 125 beneficiaries, 2 first aid lecture to 50 person and distribution of seven first aid bags, distribution of medication to 150 person. The psychosocial support to 325 children and 145 adults. Lastly the health promotion and personal hygiene to 294 person.

The IRCS Erbil and Mosul Branches

1. New arrived **24 families** to Khazer
2. 63 families from Hasan shame returned to their home in Mosul city
3. 30,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
4. Distribution of 1000 hot meals with the BCF
5. 303 medical cases were treated in Khazer camp with the Qatar Red Crescent
6. 60 medical cases were treated at the night shift in Hasan Shame camp
7. 25 families in Hasan Shame U2 received relief pack (each pack contain one food basket, 35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set, 2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets and tarpaulin). the ICRC Item
8. Distribution of 27 ready meals with water bottle sets to the newly arrived families in Hasan Shame
9. Distribution 208,000 liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps

The IRCS health teams delivered first aid lectures to 43, psychosocial support program to 55 children beside the health promotion and personal hygiene to 90 people of different age group.
