Agrab Checkpoint

10th -11th March 2017

The Aqrab checkpoint is a screening zone at Gahish village; the point where the IDP families from east bank of Mosul are transferred toward the camps, the IRCS team had grounded health and relief teams for rapid respond; these teams equipped with two ambulances with first aid bags and items, mobile kitchen for preparing the hot meals and added 6 latrines to the service

New arrival 1800 families arrived Madraj camp of them 344 families send to Jama Kur camp

The past 2-day's activities as listed below

The IRCS branches of Salahaddin, Mosul and Muthana

Agrab checkpoint

- 1. 49 person evacuated by our ambulances to the neighboring hospital
- 2. 296 person received first aid service
- 3. 1000 hot meals distributed to the families
- 4. Ready meals pack total of 500 distributed
- 5. Primary psychosocial support 490 people

The camps

- 1. Producing and distributing 12000 fresh piece of bread to camps of Tel-Sebat
- 2. Total 2400 hot meals delivered immediately to the new families in Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 3. 1000 Relief Pack distributed in Hamam al Madraj and Haj Ali camps each pack contain (food basket, hygiene set and kitchen set).

The IRCS Erbil Branch

This team operate in Khazer and Hasan Shame camps including Jama Kur

- 1. 120.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
- 2. Distribution of 1500 hot meals with the BCF
- 3. 70 Ready meals pack delivered to the families
- 4. 225-relief pack distributed to the new families in Jama Kur camp. Each relief pack contain (one food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set ,2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets, stove ,thermos ,tarpaulin and 2towel)ICRC items
- 4. Distribution 320,000iter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
- 5. Total of 730 Medical cases treated as 344 at Qatar RC, 276 at Hasan Shame night shift and 110 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC
- 6. The IRCS health teams delivered
 - 2 first aid lectures to 36 people
 - Psychosocial support program to 124 children.65 families and 39 young men
 - The health promotion and personal hygiene to 144 people of different age group.
 - 24 Yazidis families received psychosocial support and hygiene sets
