Nowruz Celebrations

21st -22nd March 2017

Crowd management IRCS join the Iraqis in all celebration or commemoration including Nowruz, the IRCS prepare teams with ambulances and satellite phone to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the crowd through evacuation, relief, first aid services and assist in finding missing person

The IRCS joined the People of Kurdistan with the crowd management teams during Nowruz festival for the past week especially on March $21^{\rm st}$

The past wo-day's activities as listed below

The IRCS Salahaddin, Mosul, Missan, Basra, Babel and IRCS/HQ

Agrab Checkpoint

- 1. 86 person evacuated by our ambulances to the neighboring hospital
- 2. 7000 hot meals distributed to the families
- 3. Ready meals pack total of 1400 distributed

The Camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat "Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside agrab check point
- 2. Our water purification unit produces 2m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
- 3. 2400 hot meal distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 4. Medical cases 308 cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
- 5. 3000 relief pack distributed to the families (each pack with food basket and 35 Kg rice) with the ICRC in Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 6. Health team
 - Primary psychosocial support to 775 person
 - First aid services 415 person

Inside cities

- 1. Inside Mosul 1000 families in Hay Al-Shuhada'a received relief pack (each pack with one food basket and 2 water bottle sets)
- 2. 50 blankets distributed in Al-Qayara hospital for wounded patients

The IRCS Erbil with Karbala Branches

- 1. Jama kur camp received 70 new families
- 2. 120.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
- 3. Distribution of 2000 hot meals with the BCF
- 4. 333 relief pack in Hasan shame of (one food basket ,35Kg rice, kitchen set and hygiene set ,2 Jerri can, kettle, 6 blankets, stove ,thermos ,tarpaulin and 2towel)ICRC items
- 5. Distribution to the families of Jama Kur 200 cloth boxes with the Turkish RC
- 6. Distribution 724,000Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
- 7. Total of 1047 Medical cases treated as :639 at Qatar RC, 176 at Hasan Shame night shift and 232 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC
- 8. The IRCS health teams place 2 Units for emergency first aid service at the highway between Erbil-Sulaymania the other between Shaqlawa -Erbil to serve the people at Nowruz
